

Strappy Leaf Native Pack

Anigozanthos manglesii

Red and Green Kangaroo Paw

height: 1.2m

fauna: Insects, birds and mammals



The Red and Green Kangaroo Paw is a herbaceous, clump-forming perennial with long, green, strappy leaves, and flower stalks to 1.2 m high. This plant is Western Australia's state floral emblem and attracts nectar loving birds.

Conostylis aculeata

Spiny Cottonheads

height: 0.5m

fauna: Insects and reptiles



Spiny Cottonheads are versatile, enjoying a range of positions. Suitable for denser plantings and will perform well in full sun or light shade. Yellow flowers from Aug – Nov.

Dianella revoluta var. diavaricata

height: 0.7m

fauna: Insects, birds, frogs, mammals and reptiles



Strappy leaved, tufted perennial. Foliage is blue-grey/green with blue/purple flowers in bloom from Sept – Dec.

Ficinia nodosa

Knotted Club Rush

height: Up to 1m

fauna: Insects, reptiles and frogs



Grassy rush growing up to 1m tall with flowers blooming Oct – Dec with a brown/cream colour. This reeded grass grows well in free draining sandy soils and performs excellent water filtration.

Patersonia occidentalis

Purple Flag, Native Iris

height: 0.4–0.8m

fauna: Insects



It's striking three-petalled flowers in blue, violet or purple appear in late spring to early summer, but can appear at other times throughout the year. These flowers are held above the foliage for a stunning display that also attracts native bees.

Macarthuria australis

height: 0.75m

A low shrub with white to cream flowers on the newer growth from May – Dec or Jan – Feb. Well suited to sandy soils.
