Rough brown linear bark with slender green leaves. Clusters of white, nectar-filled flowers during spring and summer attract bees and birds.

Very dark brown to black bark. The dramatic bark colour forms a great backdrop to the lanceolate grey-green foliage. Flowers are produced from winter to early spring and can vary from creamy white to pink and red in colour.

A beautifully shaped shade tree with fibrous rough bark. Clusters of white-cream flowers bloom from January to April.



Common name: Jacaranda

Botanical name: Jacaranda mimosifolia

A deciduous tree with soft fine green foilage turning yellow before shedding. Large clusters of purple bell-shaped flowers form in summer, followed by curved green seed pods.



Common name: Broad leaved paperbark

Botanical name: Melaleuca quinquenervia

White flaky paper-like bark. Leathery textured green grey leaves forming a dense canopy. Creamy white bottle brush-like flowers appear in autumn.

Deciduous tree with large 5-lobed leaves turning burnt orange and yellow in autumn before falling. Bark is smooth cream in colour with a camouflage-like mottled texture. Small round seed balls form and hang through the winter.



Common name: Chinese elm

Small dark green oval-shaped foliage with serrated edges. Deciduous, with mottled flaky bark varying in colour between brown, reddish brown, dark grey and cream.

Common name: Zelkova Serrata 'Green Vase'
